PHIL KEARNY CWRT OF NORTH JERSEY HISTORY

The Phil Kearny Civil War Round Table was originally formed as the 41st New Jersey Infantry Round Table over 20 years ago. We met at a Barnes & Noble Book Store in Woodland Park, NJ, where liked minded people with an interest in the American Civil War met monthly to discuss books and topics as well as invited speakers and noted authors to come and speak to our group.

As we grew larger, we moved to accommodate our growing membership to the Wayne Public Library and changed our name to honor the famous one armed New Jersey general Phil Kearny, who led the New Jersey Brigade early in the war and was killed at the Battle of Chantilly in September 1862.

Today, PKCWRT usually meets on the third Wednesday of the month at the Hasbrouck Heights Municipal Building at 7:00pm - downstairs. We have summers off, July & August and reconvene in September. All are welcomed to attend.

In November, the Phil Kearny Civil War Round Table sponsors an annual field trip to a Civil War battlefield, where licensed guides educate and tour the battlefield with our members.

Also, in December, we have a Holiday Party, where a noted speaker or author will be the highlight of our annual dinner.
