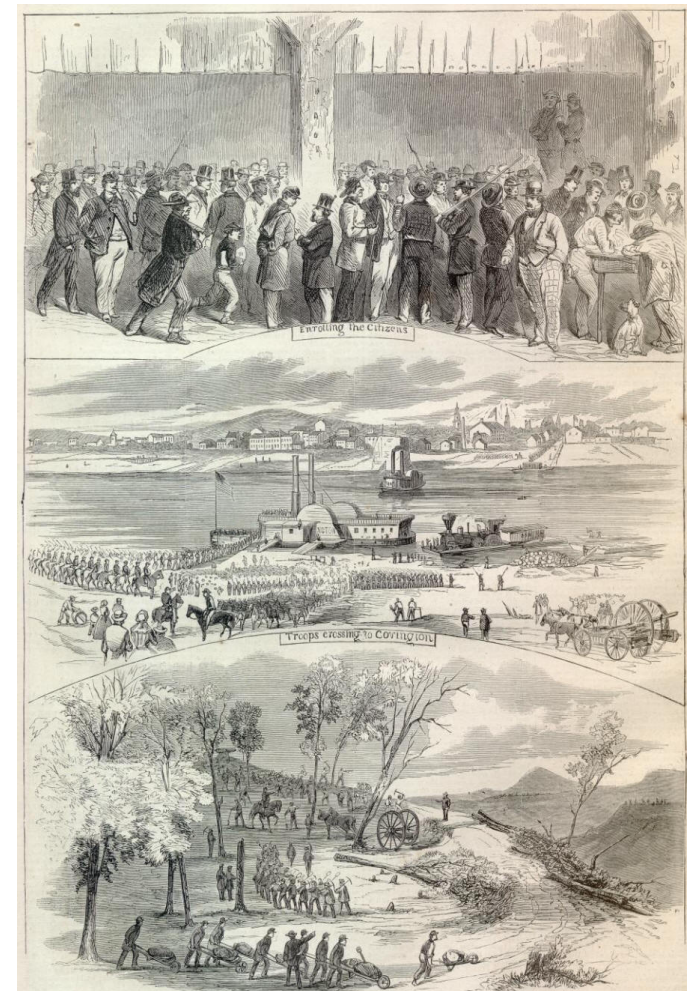

During the American Civil War, Cincinnati played a crucial role in preserving the United States. Not only was Cincy the North's most populous in the West, but also it was the nation's third most productive manufacturing center.

The Queen City of the West served as a key provider of the Union's soldiers, weapons, supplies, medical aid, and political influencers. In this presentation, Cincinnati historian David L. Mowery will reveal several of the Queen City's key structures, such as military installations, hospitals, churches, businesses, and private homes, in the way they appeared at the time of the Civil War.
