


Q1 Does your CWRT have a single, regular meeting place?





Q3 Which factor weighted most to influenced the CWRT venue choice?



Q4 Is there an associated cost or contractual obligation to meet at your venue?







Q7 How much does the CWRT pay for each meeting?



Q8 How satisfied are YOU with the current meeting venue?


